Thank you to Rose and Dick Sawyer for their fabulous donation of a filing cabinet to the theatre. It will be put to good use!

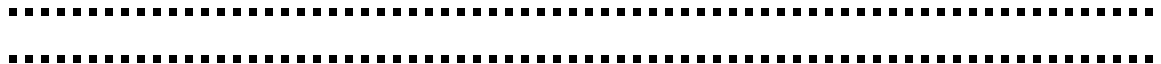
